<b>A</b>	Services available at no charge for Ventura County residents aged 60 and older.
<b>AA</b>	Scholarships available.
<b>B</b>	Services available at no charge for <i>Eligible Family Caregivers</i> , which are defined as unpaid, informal caregivers who are: (1) age 18 or older caring for a person age 60 or older; or (2) age 55 or older residing with and caring for a child age 18 or under. Care receiver must reside in Ventura County.
<b>C</b>	To receive these services, the care receiver <u>must</u> have at least two Activities of Daily Living (ADLs) impairments (walking, eating, dressing, bathing, toileting or transferring in/out of bed) -and/or- have a cognitive impairment.
<b>D</b>	Services available on sliding scale fee.
<b>E</b>	Available only to low income, unemployed Ventura County residents aged 55 and older. No fee. Veterans receive priority.
<b>F</b>	Services available at no charge for persons age 60 and older residing in Camarillo, Fillmore, Moorpark, Oxnard, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks and Ventura.
<b>G</b>	Services available at no charge for care receivers residing in Camarillo, Fillmore, Moorpark, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks, Newbury Park, Oak Park and portions of Westlake Village in Ventura County.
<b>H</b>	Services available at no charge for care receivers residing in Oxnard, Port Hueneme, Santa Paula and Ventura.
